How to instruct in-car and reinforce the classroom teaching

- Reinforce your lessons 3 times
 - Verbal, Physical and Repeat



What should you identify in a driver who wants to solo, but isn't ready? How to encourage them to keep learning

How do you identify a solo ready driver and how to send them out alone the first time (be there on hot pits for them!)

- Discuss the student with the Chief of Instruction Before Sending them out
- Notify the Grid Captain and have them notify the corner workers Before Track session
- Watch your student from the Hot Pits with the Grid Captain. Be ready to discuss things or have them pulled off track if they aren't ready
- Have a one/one discussion with the student after their solo session. Discuss their session
- Always encourage the student to get more car and classroom time with instructors.
